The Use of Incense

During this winter season, we will use incense at least one Mass. There are seven Masses on the weekend starting on November 18.

Incense will be used at

-Nov. 18, St. Anne, 5 p.m.

-Nov. 25-26, all Masses, most likely (Solemnity of Jesus Christ, King of the Universe)

-Dec. 3, St. Bernard, 7 a.m.

Here is some of the significance of incense:

-Incense was used in the Temple at 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.

-Incense symbolizes our prayers rising (see Ps 141:2), purification, and the mystery of the Holy Spirit.

-The burning charcoal symbolizes zeal; the fragrance coming from the incense symbolizes virtue.

-The word *incense* appears in the Bible 73 times!
