The Use of Incense

Incense will be used:

-Nov. 18, St. Anne, 5 p.m.

-Nov. 25-26, all Masses, most likely (Solemnity of Jesus Christ, King of the Universe)

-Dec. 3, St. Bernard, 7 a.m.

Here is some of the significance of incense:

- Incense was used in the Temple at 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- Incense symbolizes our prayers rising (see Ps 141:2), purification, and the mystery of the Holy Spirit.
- The burning charcoal symbolizes zeal; the fragrance coming from the incense symbolizes virtue.
- The word *incense* appears in the Bible 73 times!
